Next Monday 16th May 2016 sees the start of this seasons Llewellyn Jenkins Memorial Cup. In the first round Park A are at home to Roath B and Riverside are at home to Docks. I have previously sent you all an email explaining this year's format etc. and below is a reminder.

HANDICAPS

Individual handicaps amended as of the February 2016 delegates meeting will be used – details are on the website at

FORMAT

The format used last season will continue – 4 frames to be played in total – 2 single matches to begin, followed by one doubles match followed by a final singles match.

1 point to be awarded to the winner of the singles match and 2 points awarded to the winners of the doubles match – The team with 3 points will win the match.

Both captains will provide the names of 5 of his/her elected players to the opposing captain and a blind draw will be made; the order the names are selected will serve as the match order.

Please note – We have dropped the match time back by half an hour to begin at 8pm to allow a little more flexibility for players however it is imperative that both teams have 5 players ready and available to play at **8pm** prompt on match night.

If any team is unable to provide 5 players at the start of the match that team will forfeit a frame and subsequent point for each player they are missing and a draw will be made for the remainder of the frames if any are still to be played.

The New name for this year's Open Singles tournament is the "Bill Gourlay Open Singles Tournament" named after a long standing member of the league who represented Caerphilly Cons and who passed away a number of years ago.

The final of this tournament concludes on Tuesday 17th May 2016 at Park Cons. The match will start at 7pm and is between Luke Haines (County D) and Sean O'Connell (Riverside). Good luck to both. Please inform your fellow team mates. Thanks.
