

Decision with regard to teams only being able to field four players.

Teams will only be able allowed to have a player who has already played in the match play again in the fifth frame under the following conditions. Five frames of snooker MUST be played on any given match night.

- 1) If the frame score is 3-1 or 4-0 against them. They will be allowed to field one of their players who has already lost (drawn "out of a hat" by the opposition captain) to play the fifth frame. If that player wins the frame they will be awarded the one point for the win.
- 2) If the frame score is 2-2 or 3-1 for the team with four players then they will be allowed to field a fifth player who has already lost, again (drawn "out of a hat" by opposition captain) to play the fifth frame. However under these circumstances if that player wins the frame they will NOT be awarded the one point for the win and the frame scores will remain the same. However if they lose the frame the opposing team WILL be awarded the one point.
- 3) If the frame score is 4-0 for the team with four players then the fifth player will be drawn "out of a hat" by the opposition captain) to play the fifth frame. If that player wins that frame they will NOT be awarded the one point for the win and the frame scores will remain the same. However if they lose the frame the opposing team WILL be awarded the one point.
- 4) Finally, if two teams both have only four players the fifth frame will be played by a player who has already played in one of the first 3 frames and will be nominated by his team captain.
